




WHY DO WE NEED TO RE-DESIGN THE ECONOMY?


- The Current Global Economy Is Not Working and things are expected to get worse due to:

 - Unstable political- and social systems caused by environmental degradation & climate change.



EU COMMISSION CIRCULAR ECONOMY PROPOSALS – ANNOUNCED DEC 2, 2015


- The Circular Economy proposals aim to make Europe more resource-efficient.
- Proposals issued today include a legally binding recycling rate of 65% across the EU by 2030 and a maximum limit to the amount of household waste that can be landfilled at 10% by the same year.
- New Ecodesign plan aimed at setting product design requirements for manufacturers so that goods are made to last longer and are more repairable and recyclable.


